

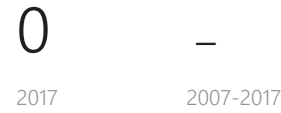

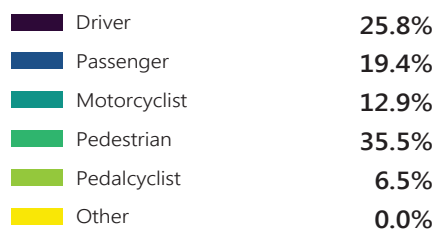
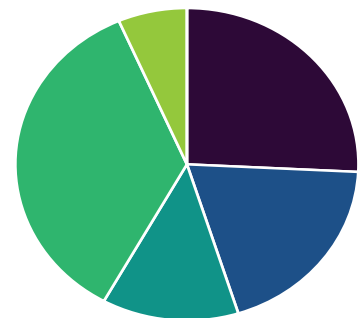


### HIGHWAY FATALITY RATE

Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2017

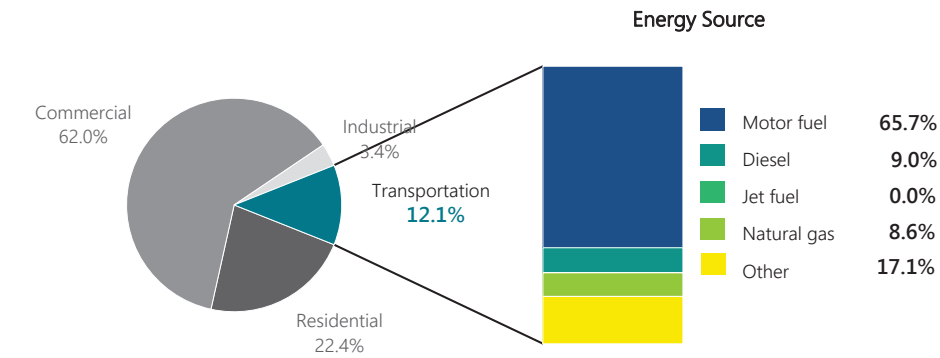


### HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON

Percent of Btu consumed, 2016



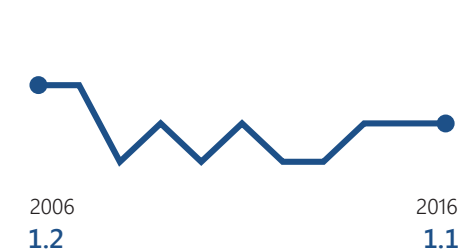
### TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE

Trillion Btu consumed, 2006-2016



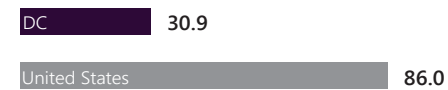
### TRANSPORTATION EMISSIONS

Million metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub>, 2006-2016



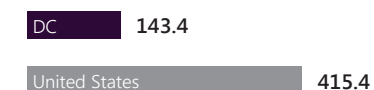
### TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE PER CAPITA

Million Btu per capita, 2016



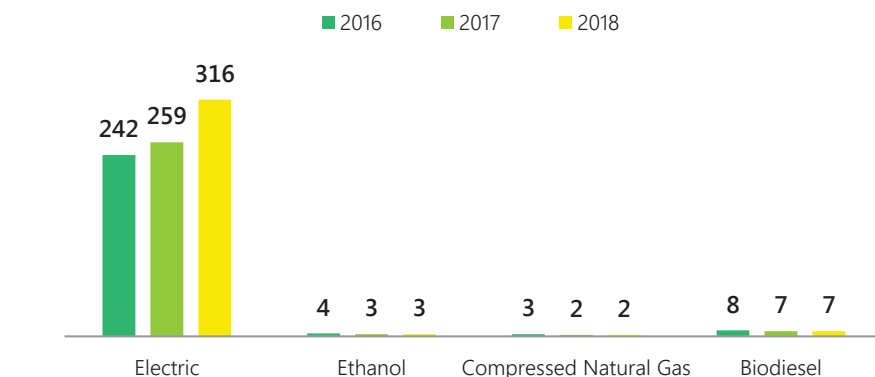
### HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA

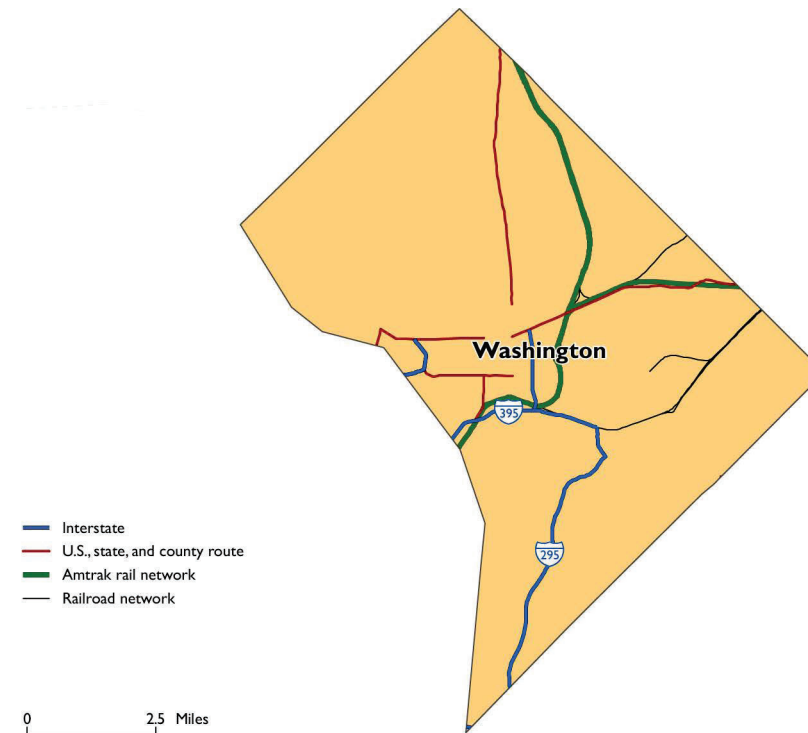

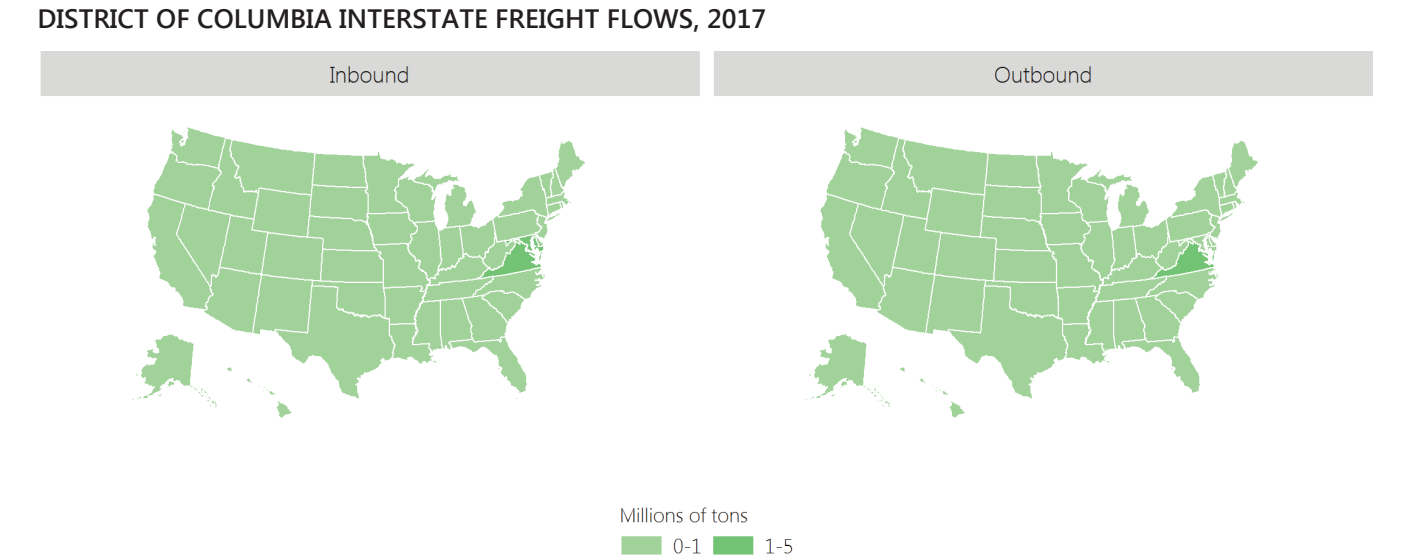

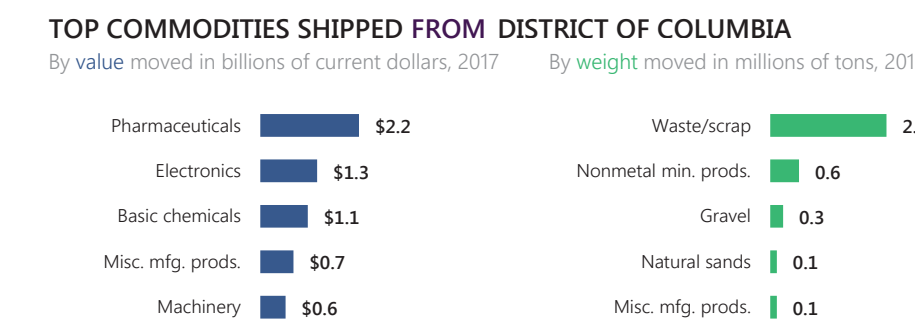
