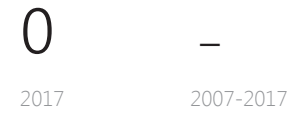

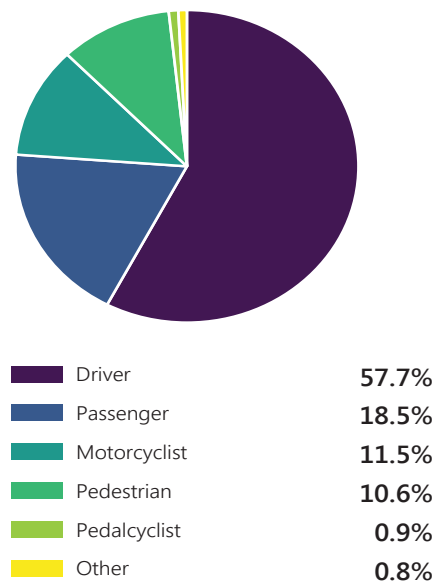


HIGHWAY FATALITY RATE

Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2017

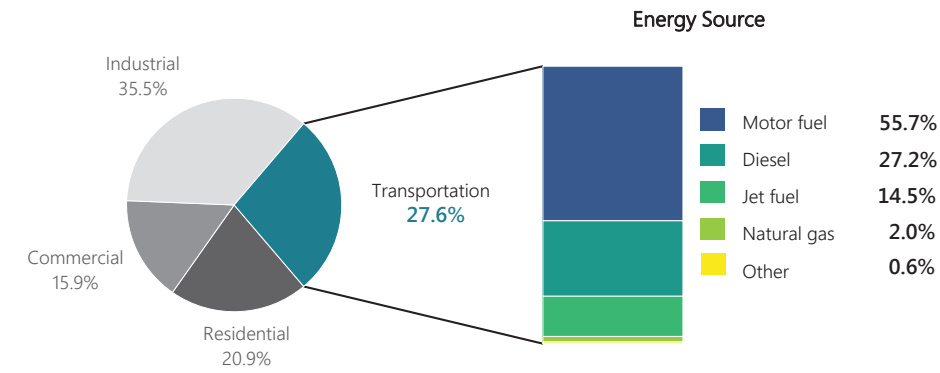


HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON



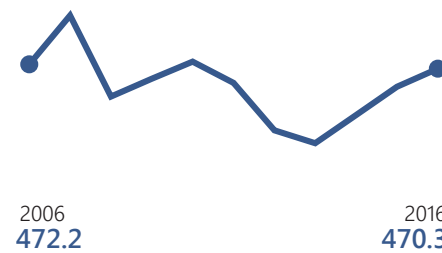
ENERGY USE BY SECTOR

Percent of Btu consumed, 2016



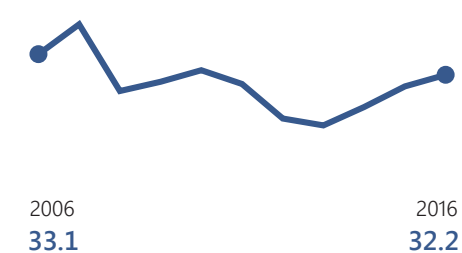
TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE

Million Btu per capita, 2016



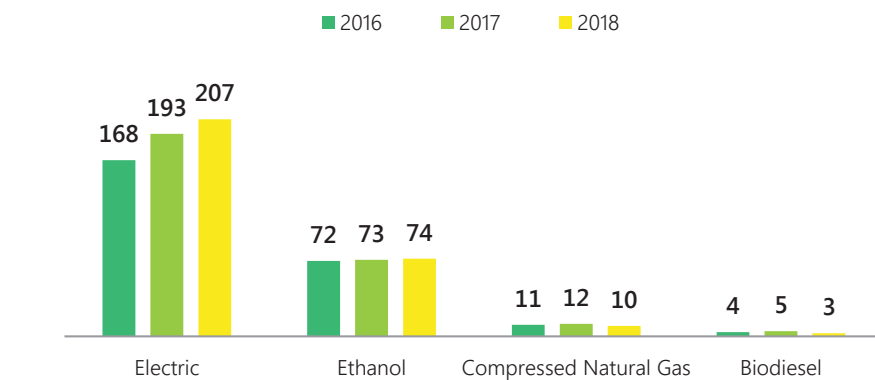
HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA

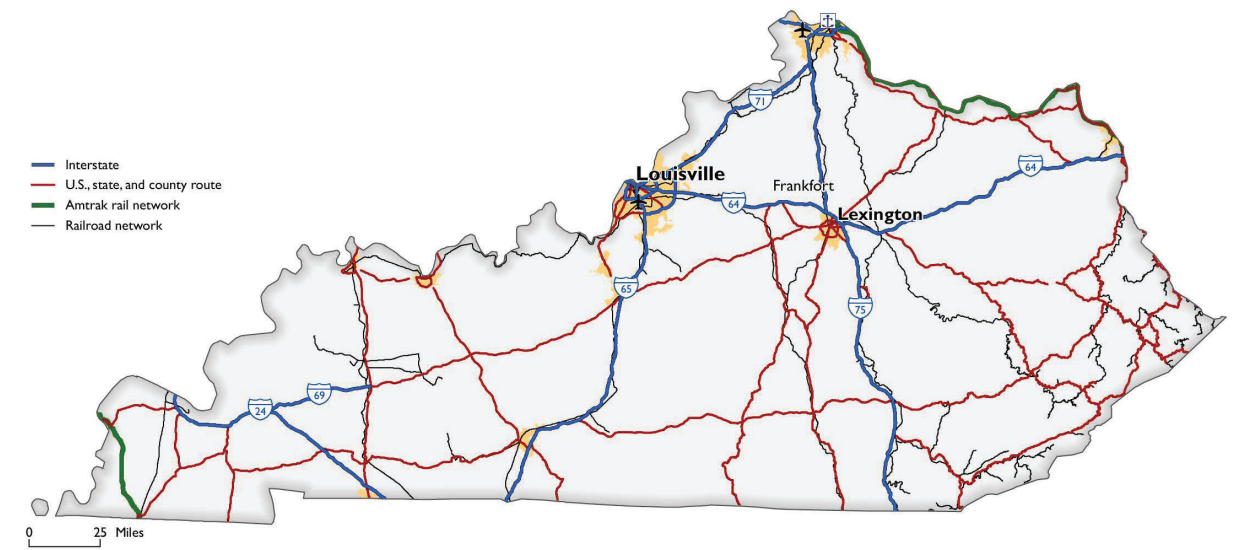

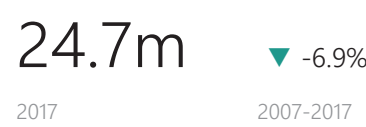

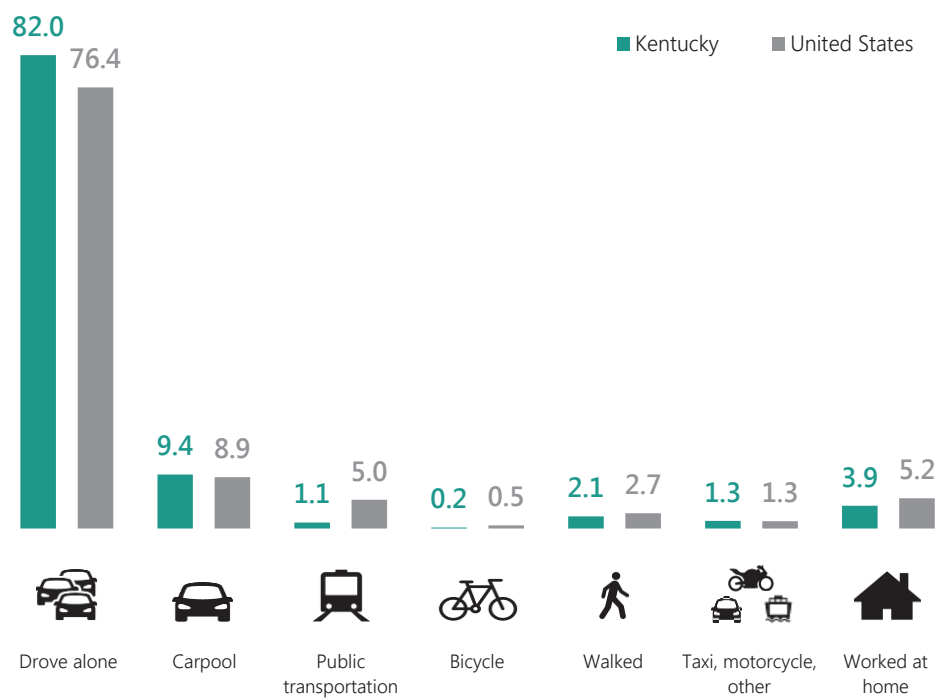

Miles per person per day, 2017



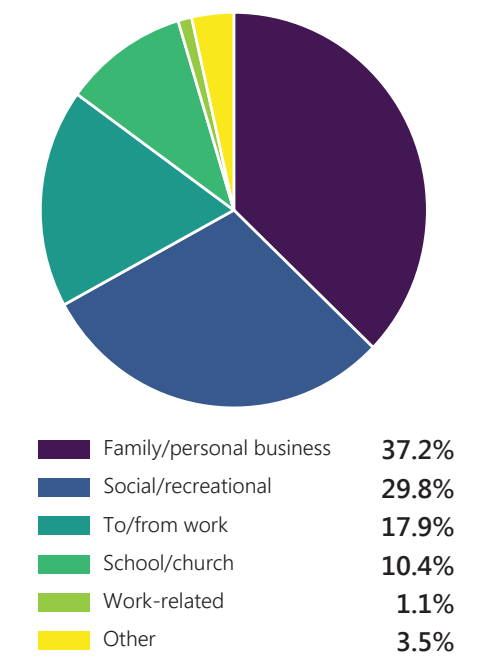
AVERAGE DAILY PERSON TRIPS

Trips per person per day, 2017



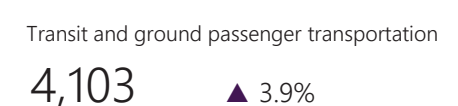
PASSENGER TRAVEL BY TRIP PURPOSE

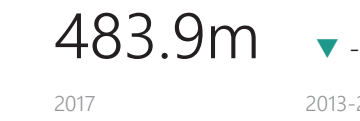

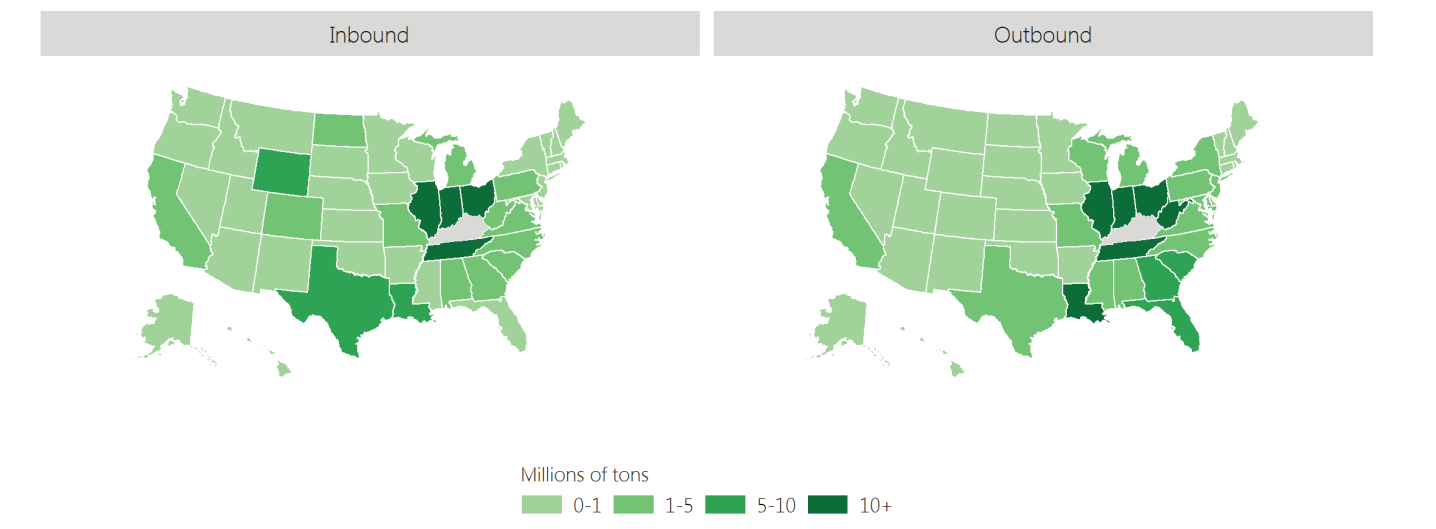
TONS OF FREIGHT FLOW

KENTUCKY INTERSTATE FREIGHT FLOWS, 2017



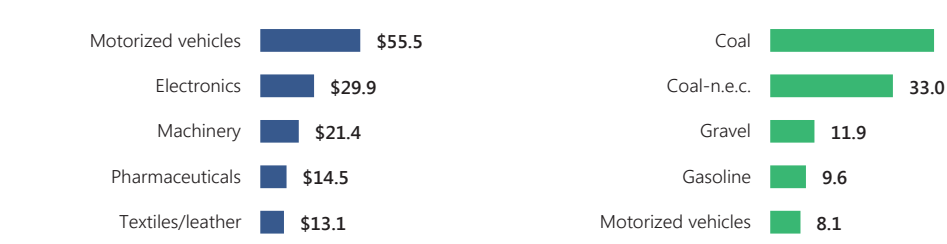
STATE GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT



TOP COMMODITIES SHIPPED FROM KENTUCKY

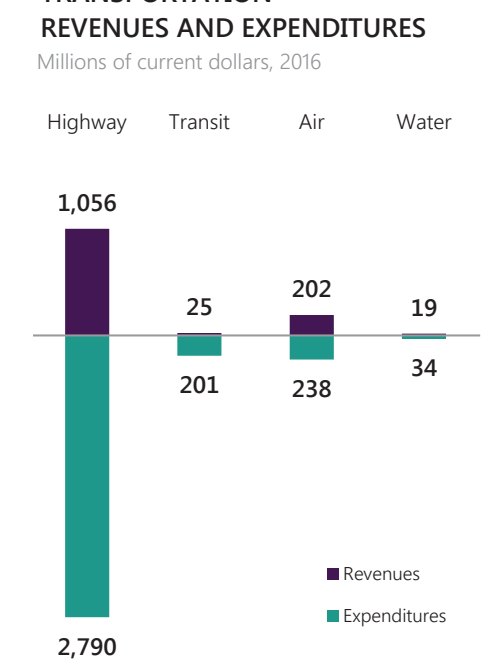
By value moved in billions of current dollars, 2017

STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES

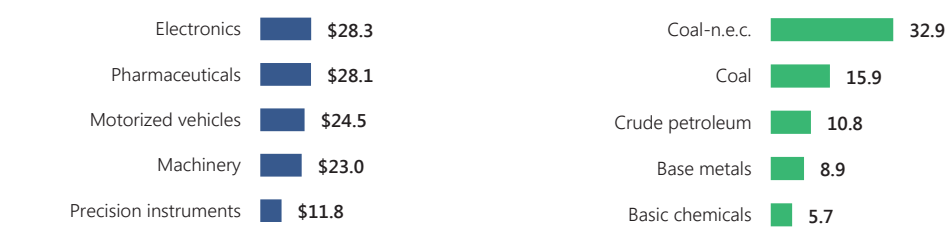
