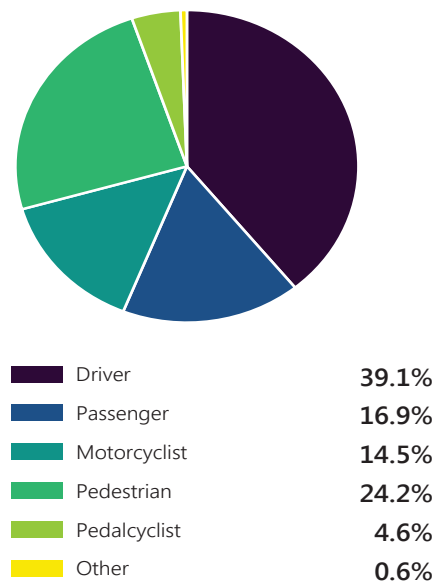


HIGHWAY FATALITY RATE

Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2017

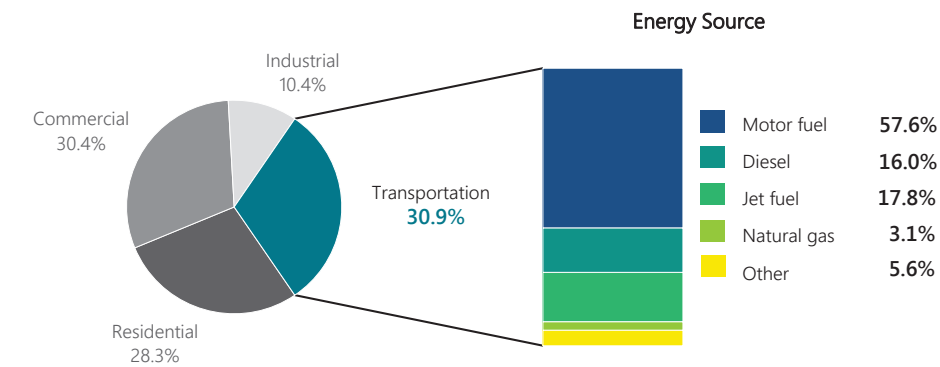


HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON

Million metric tons of CO₂, 2006-2016



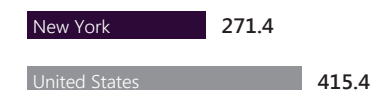
TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE PER CAPITA

Million Btu per capita, 2016



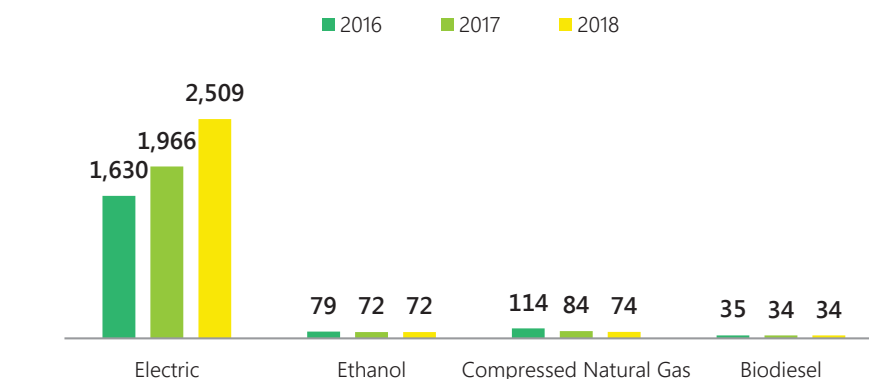
HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA

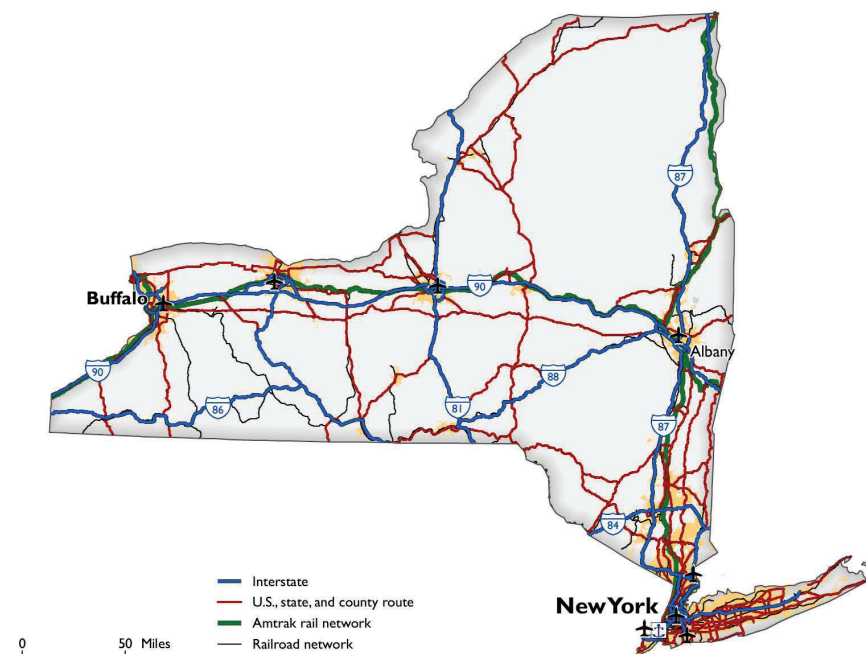

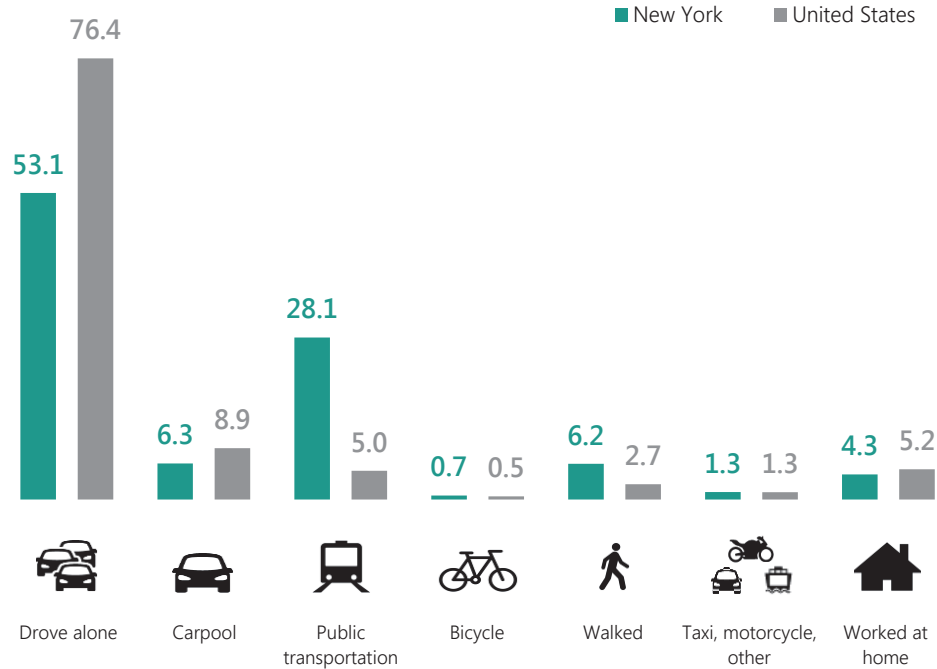

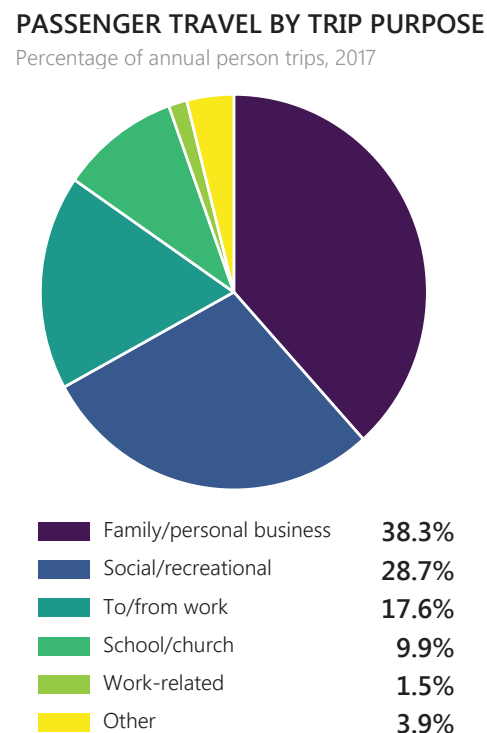

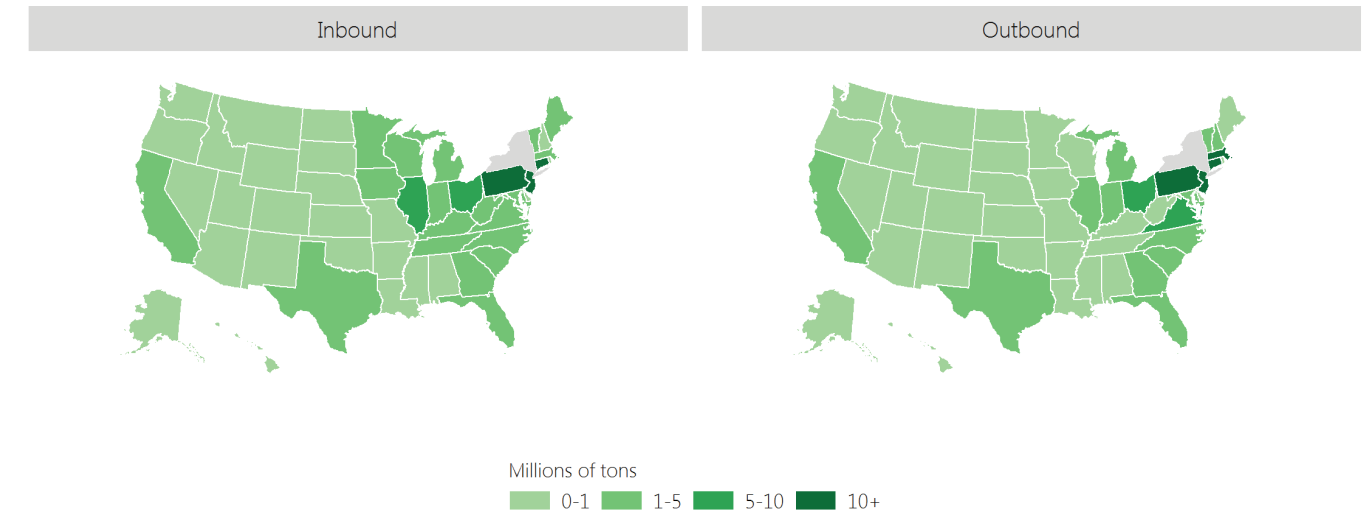

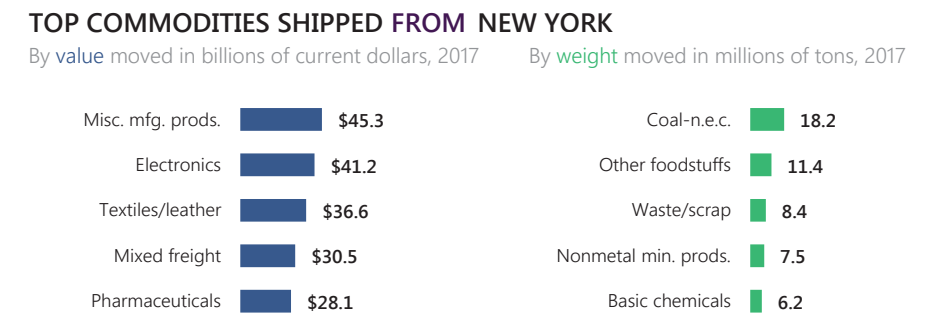
