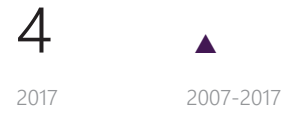

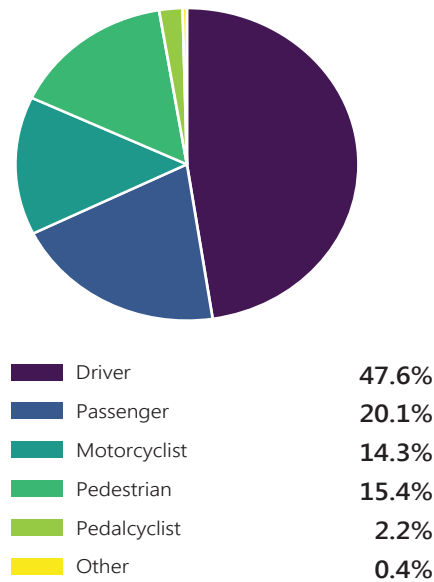


HIGHWAY FATALITY RATE

Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2017

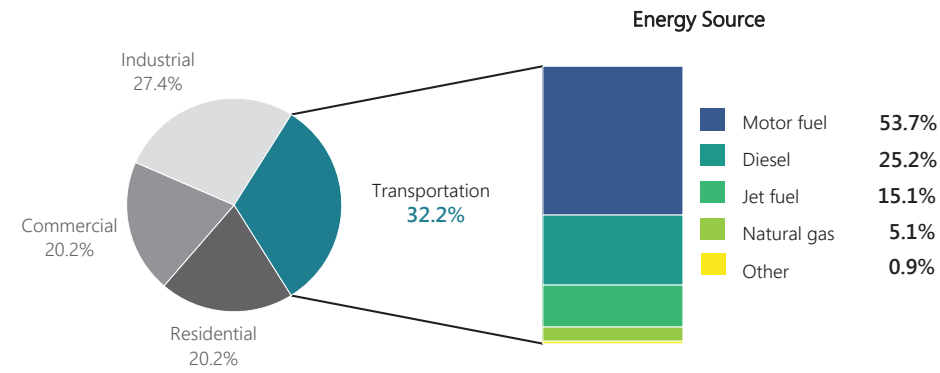


HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON



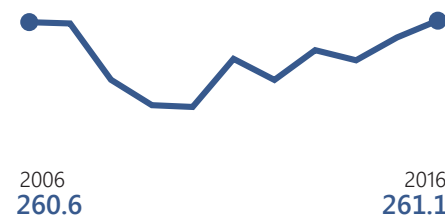
ENERGY USE BY SECTOR

Percent of Btu consumed, 2016



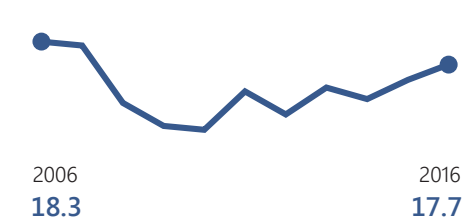
TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE

Million Btu per capita, 2016



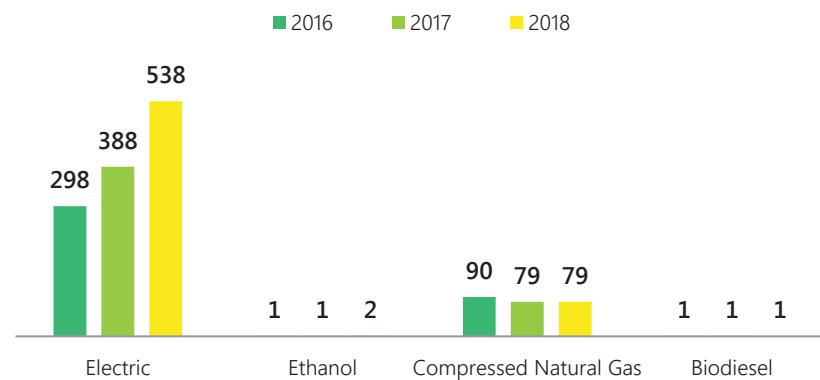
HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA

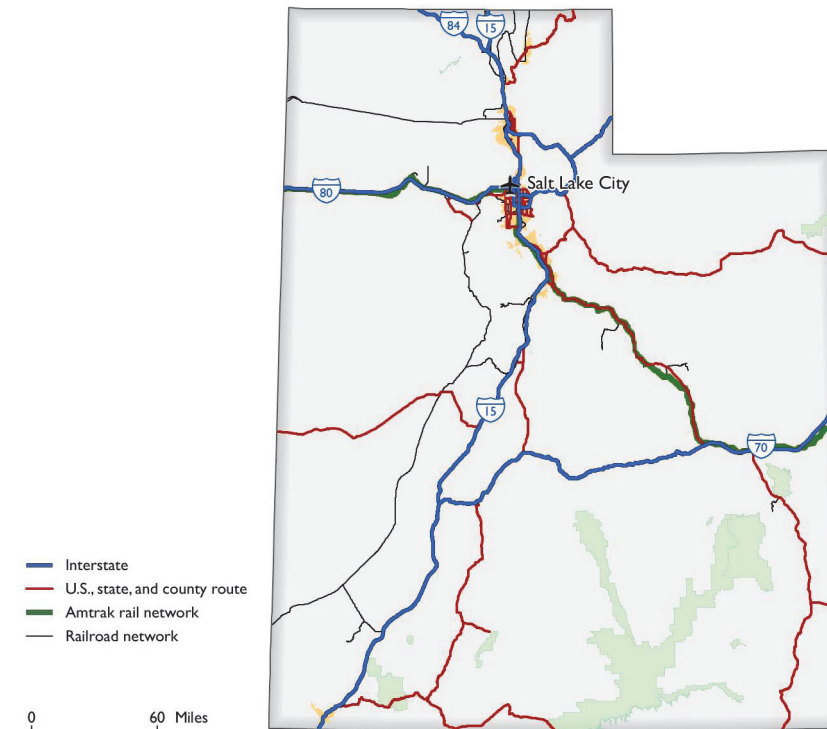

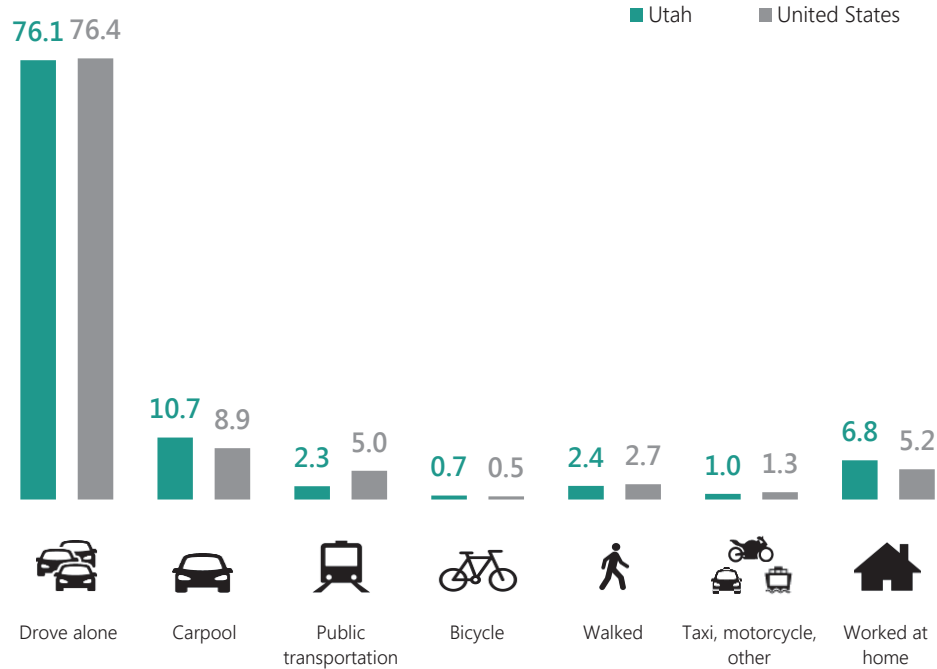

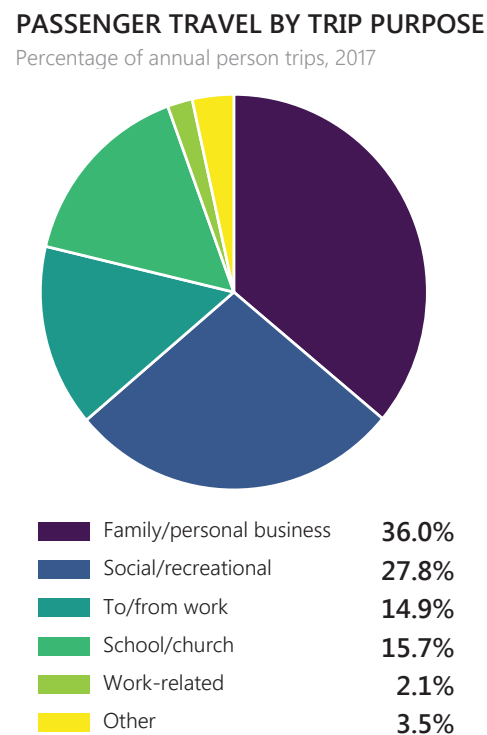

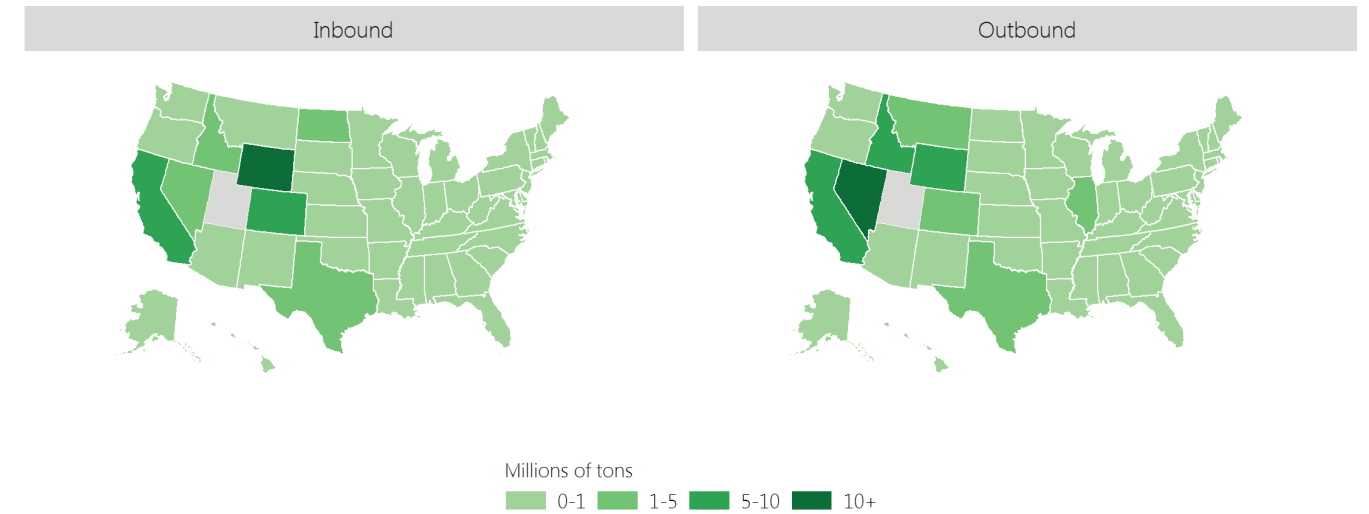

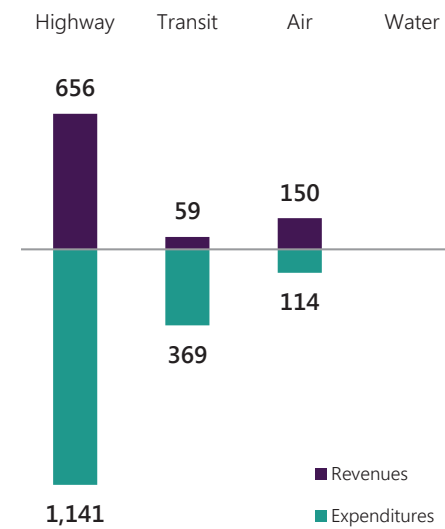

UTAH INTERSTATE FREIGHT FLOWS, 2017

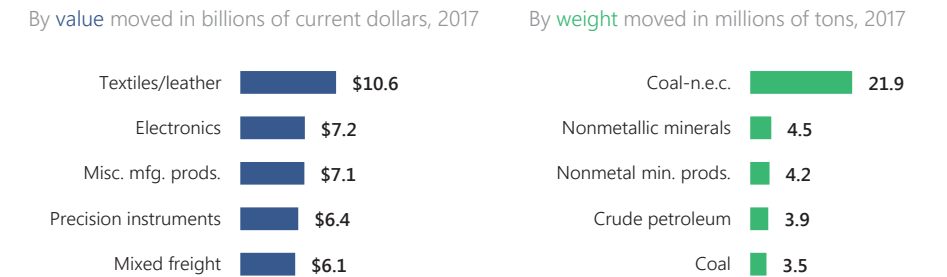

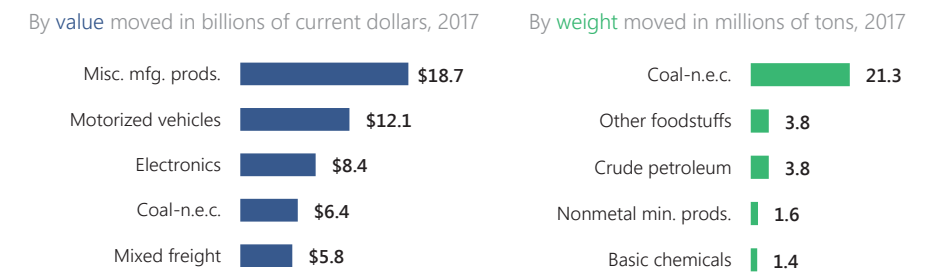
STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES
Millions of current dollars, 2016



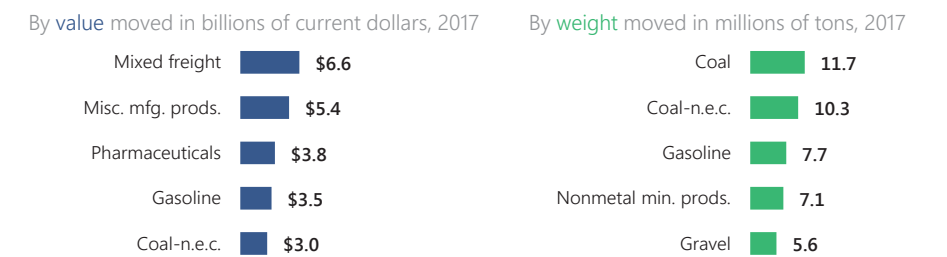
TOP COMMODITIES SHIPPED FROM UTAH
