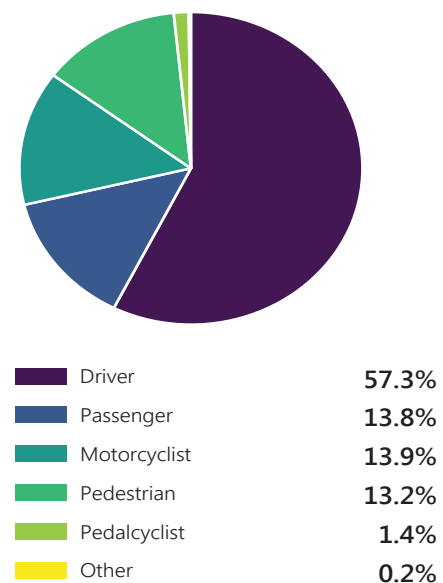


HIGHWAY FATALITY RATE

Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2017

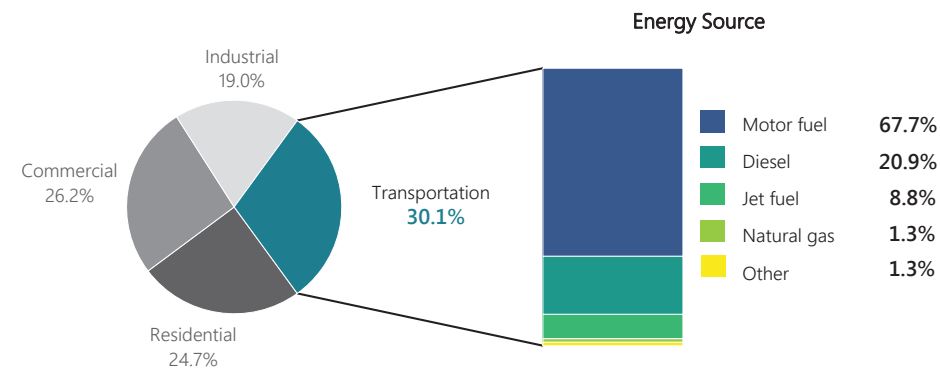

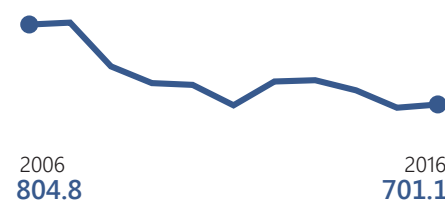
ENERGY USE BY SECTOR

Percent of Btu consumed, 2016



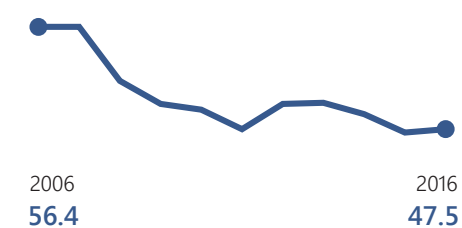

Million Btu per capita, 2016



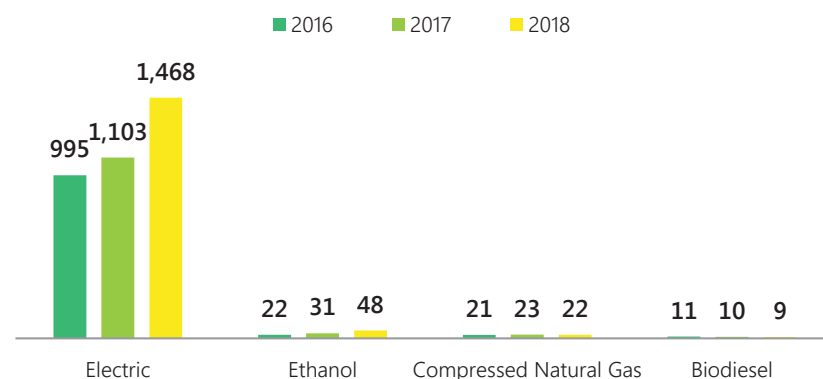
HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA

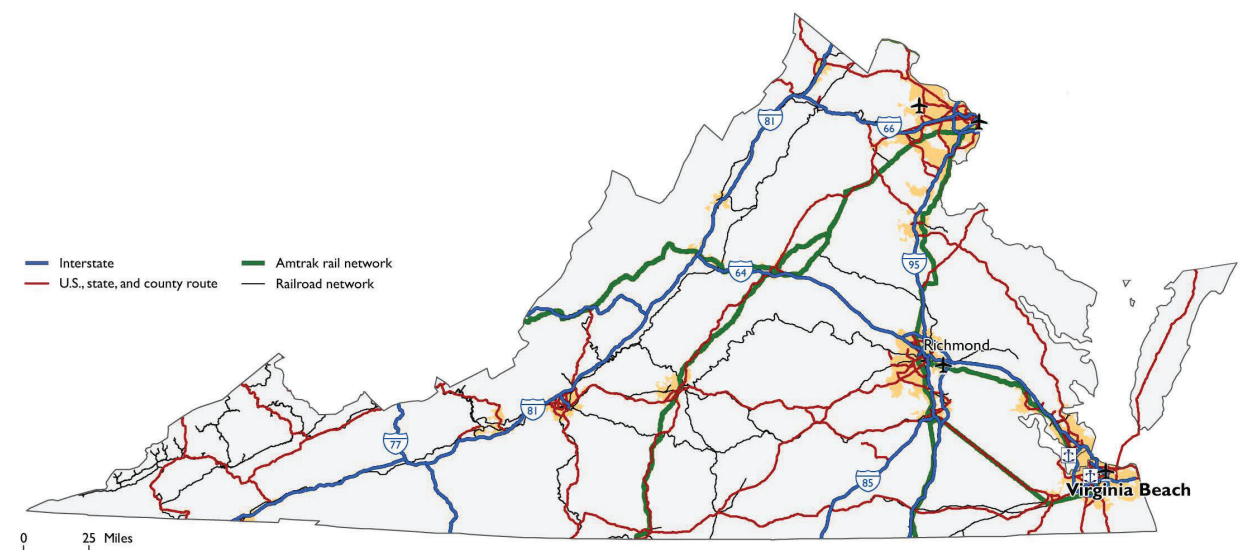

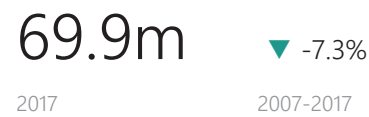

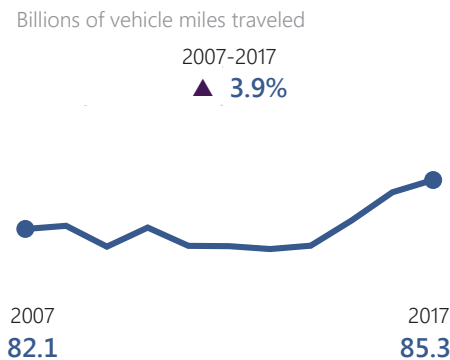

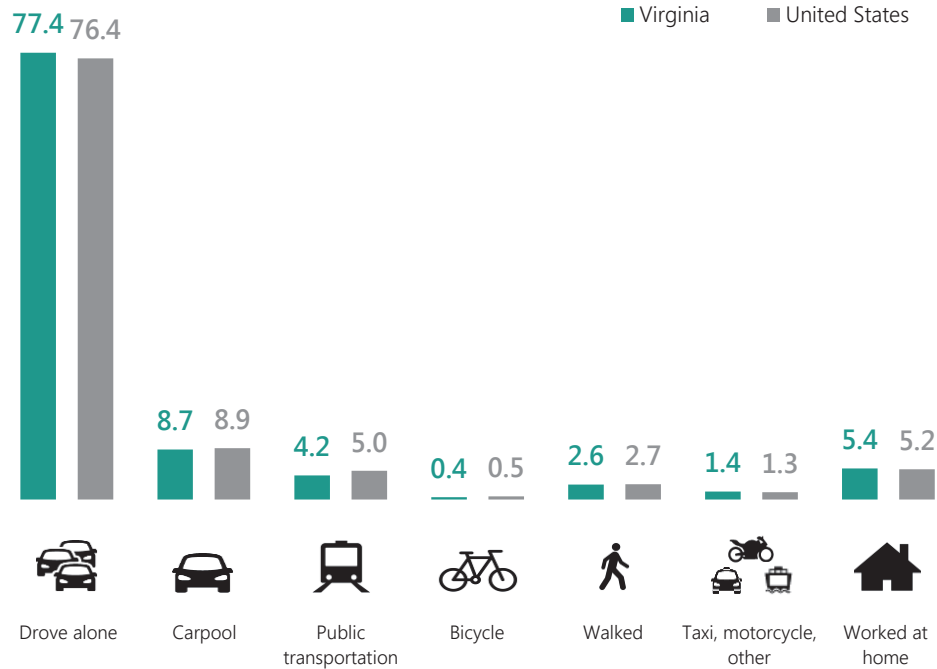

Miles per person per day, 2017



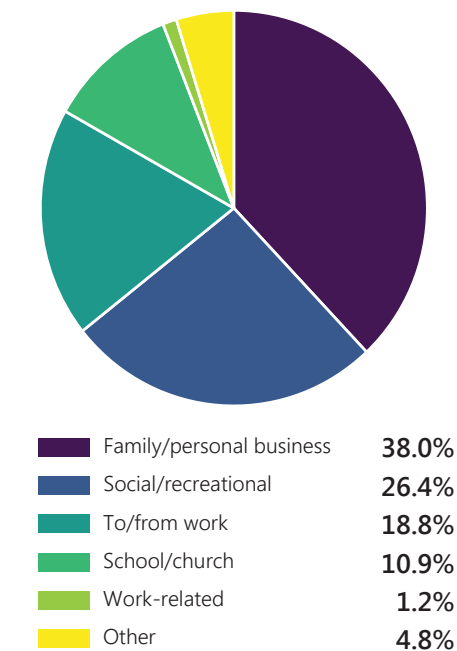
AVERAGE DAILY PERSON TRIPS

Trips per person per day, 2017

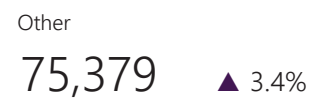
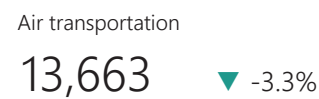
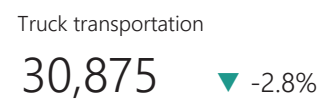
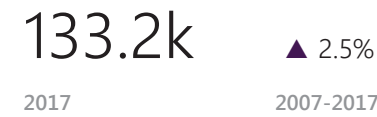


PASSENGER TRAVEL BY TRIP PURPOSE

Percentage of annual person trips, 2017



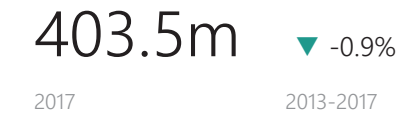

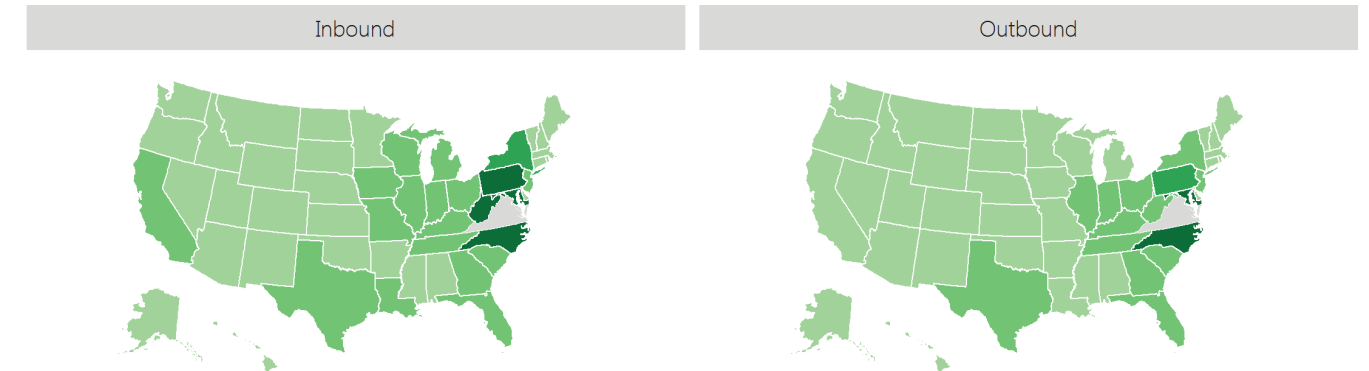
TONS OF FREIGHT FLOW

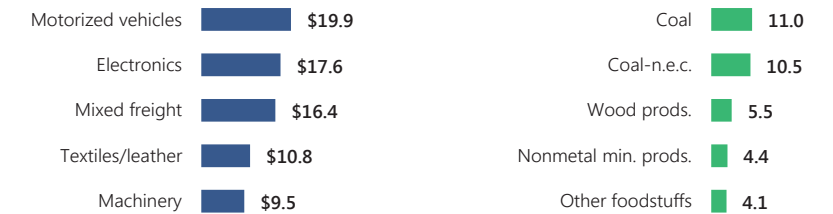

STATE GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT



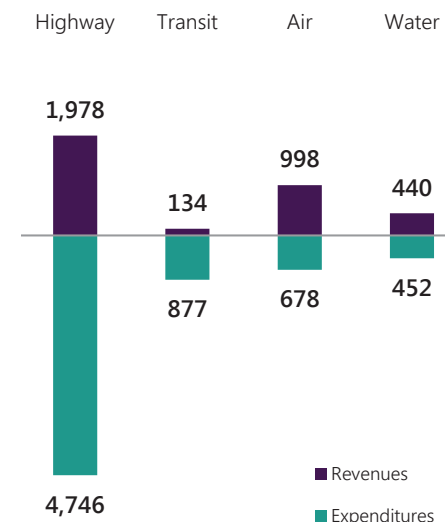
TOP COMMODITIES SHIPPED FROM VIRGINIA

By value moved in billions of current dollars, 2017 By weight moved in millions of tons, 2017



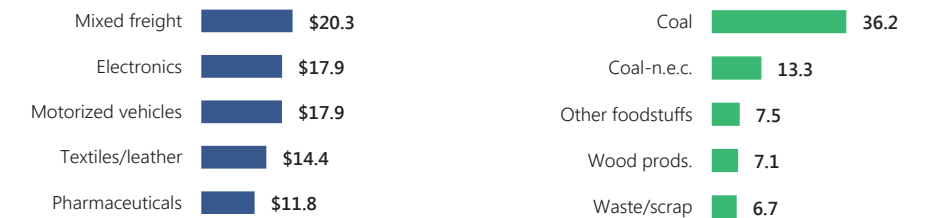
STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES
